You have purchased a **PREMIUM** ticket which entitles you to the following :-

Express boarding on Dublin - Holyhead, Rosslare - Fishguard and Belfast - Cairnryan routes as well as on our Gothenburg - Frederikshavn and Halmstad - Grenaa routes (Express boarding is **not** included on the Belfast - Liverpool route, are **not** available for vehicles towing a trailer or caravan on our Belfast - Cairnryan route and are **not** available for vans or horseboxes of 7m length or more),

Access to the Stena Plus lounge on Irish Sea routes and on sailings to Holland (please note that passengers under the age of 8 years are not permitted in the Stena Plus lounge on the Belfast - Cairnryan, Belfast - Liverpool, Dublin - Holyhead, Rosslare - Fishguard & Harwich - Hook of Holland routes. Stena Plus access is **not** included on routes between Germany, Poland, Latvia, Denmark, Finland and Sweden).

Breakfast on our Gothenburg - Kiel route.

Changes are permitted and no amendment fee is payable. However any difference in fare, or additional items added are payable. Visit our website or call the reservations number on 01 871 4711 as soon as you need to change your booking. A service fee of €7.50 for vehicles or €2.50 for foot travel will apply for amendments made via the call centre or at ports. If you cancel your booking, you are entitled to a refund depending on how far in advance you notify us.

ROUTE INFORMATION

HOLYHEAD (T5) - DUBLIN (T2)

Customers with Premium bookings travelling on this route are advised to arrive 60 minutes prior to departure to avail of express boarding.

Please note there is no Bureau de Change facility available onboard.

BELFAST - CAIRNRYAN

Those with Premium bookings are advised to arrive at least 45 minutes prior to departure to avail of express boarding.

Please note: To ensure a relaxed atmosphere, passengers under the age of 8 years old are not permitted in the Stena Plus lounge nor in the hygge recline lounge.

Foot passengers:

For your own safety and comfort we only allow hand luggage on the passenger decks. All other baggage and suitcases need to be checked-in for safe carriage during the crossing.

Foot passenger boarding:

After check-in, foot passenger guests will walk from the Foot Passenger Lounge in the Terminal Building to the ship. The distance is approximately 200m which may not be feasible for some guests. For those guests in need of some assistance, we have a shuttle bus that can take you from the Terminal Building directly to the ship. Please notify our staff at check-in that you will require assistance and we will ensure that is arranged for you. It's important that you arrive to check-in at least 45 minutes before departure to allow us to put the arrangements in place for you.

Checked Baggage:

You will not be able to access your luggage during the sailing so please ensure you remove all necessary items before placing the items on the carousel.

Football attire

The wearing of football club shirts, jumpers, scarves or other clothing that is uncovered and on show is strictly prohibited when travelling in the Stena Plus lounge on our Belfast – Cairnryan route.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Please note: It is not compulsory to bring this e-ticket with you to the port but you will need to be able to quote the booking reference that is included at the top right of this e-ticket when checking-in.

Irish and British citizens travelling on our Irish Sea routes do not need a passport to travel to Britain or Ireland but are advised to take a form of identity. A valid passport, photographic driving license, International Student Card, government issued photo ID cards, health insurance/social security photographic cards, photographic bus/train pass or EU Citizen Identity Card will usually suffice. If you are travelling with children, a birth certificate will provide adequate proof of identity for your child to travel on our sailings.

Irish and British citizens travelling to Mainland Europe **must** bring a valid passport. Remember that the name on your passport must match the name on your booking, otherwise you may not be able to travel and your insurance may be invalid. Other passport holders should check with the relevant embassy regarding passport and visa requirements.

A passport for all passengers (including children and infants) is required for all trips to Continental Europe. Your passport must be less than 10 years old and have at least 3 months validity following the date of your return travel. It is your responsibility to check and observe all the health and entry requirements applicable to your journey and you should always check the latest travel guidance from your government before you travel and the guidance provided by the relevant public authorities of your destination. You must ensure that you have all documentation needed to comply with the requirements of immigration, customs, health and other relevant regulations. We reserve the right to check and record details of such documentation and to refuse you permission to board if such documentation is not produced to our satisfaction. You will be required to reimburse us in full for any fines, repatriation or other removal costs, detention costs and all related expenses, which we may bear or incur by reason of your failure to produce such documentation to the relevant authorities.

EU Roaming Fees

Whilst roaming charges when travelling in EU countries ended on 15 June 2017, the EU roaming rules only apply when you are connected to terrestrial mobile networks. The EU binding price cap does not apply if you use your mobile phone onboard via the ferry's satellite connection and, therefore, the charges set by your network provider can be high.
