
sea kayaking past the ruins of Urquhart Castle or falconry on the lawn.


















# Indulge in an exclusive wilderness fine dining experience









Name five iconic things about Scotland, and chances are one of them will be tartan or a kilt – with the odd haggis thrown in.

## Journey to St Kilda, a double UNESCO world heritage site

Our privately guided day trip to St Kilda from Skye offers a once in a lifetime adventure for clients.

St Kilda is an uninhabited archipelago (abandoned in 1930) located 50 miles west of the Outer Hebrides. It is also one of the few destinations in the world to hold a double UNESCO World Heritage Status - that puts it on a level with Machu Picchu and the Pyramids of Egypt.

As a National Nature Reserve it is also home to north west Europe's largest seabird colony including the UK's largest colony of Atlantic puffin, northern fulmar and one of the world's largest gannetaries. It's truly a mind-blowing place and totally off the radar for the majority of travellers out there.
